In a world that is filled with many "quick stop" diners, there is none finer than the Red Arrow. It has been around since 1922, and is flourishing with a mix of UNH students, blue collar workers, and even the Hollywood types (which is noted by a brass nameplates throughout). It has a grand total of 5 tables and 10 bar stools (so timing is key), and it is open 24 hours a day. The waitress staff is wonderful and the service is outstanding (so they can turn the tables over quickly). The menu consists of Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner and Dessert items, with all the usual staples and then some local favorites.

Chili with cheese sauce - one of the best that I've ever had, it had the unique ability to combine a spicy flavor with a hint of sweetness.

Pastrami Sandwich - was as good as any NY deli, it was very very tasty and the sandwich was overstuffed with meat.

Mac-n-Cheese (side) - a very large side, that the Red Arrow has perfected.

Beefy Mac - this was a house special that came on an overflowing platter. it was a dish that consisted of elbow macaroni, cheese, ground beef, cheese, onions, cheese, peppers, cheese, spices, and cheese (I think you get the point)

French Toast Sticks - was one of the best that I've ever had. It was a few slices of a thick bread (like a Texas Toast), that was cut into thirds and then deep fried...WOW is all I can say.

Whoopie Pie - a very large and surprisingly lite take on an old time classic.
